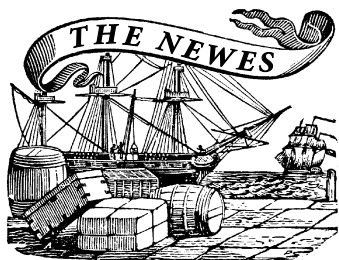

Eggs-Piration Date

ONE OF the Vineyard's best-known characters was Nancy Luce, who died in 1890. She turned personal eccentricity into a cottage industry. Tourists travelled miles by oxcart to see this peculiar, hollow-eyed spinster who allowed only female animals on her farm, and who wrote long, heartfelt elegies for her chickens. To support herself, Ms. Luce sold photos of herself, books of her verse, and eggs. When tourists arrived home with their souvenirs, if they looked closely, they found that each egg had an inscription on its shell: the name of the hen that laid it, and the egg's date of "birth." By her own reckoning, some of Nancy's eggs were years old. Probably very few ended up in an omelette.
